Collaborate with Student Support Commission to creating an **online involvement survey** 

- Reach out to student organization presidents through one-to-one meetings
- Collaborate with Community Service Commission in breaking down stigmas about sexual assault
- Work with Residence Halls and RA's to provide better resources to first-year students:
  - Getting involved in Associated Students
  - Getting involved in Student Organizations
  - Develop an open and positive relationship with the campus police department
    - Promote new police station as a safe place for students
  - Encourage students to take advantage of academic resources
  - o Launch a "More than Just Pamphlets" campaign
- Continue to work with and support the Associated
  Student's Mobile Food Pantry
  - o Reach out to more non-AS students to volunteer
  - Create a student feedback survey to better meet student needs
  - o Look into adding additional items such as toiletries
- Promote an "Open-Door" campaign for Associated Students
  - Encourage minority groups to become involved in AS
  - Create all-in-one flyer that simply explains Associated Students
- Promote an inclusive environment for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities

- o Hosting campus-wide awareness events
- o Create more awareness about invisible disabilities
- Invite members of the disability community to participate in campus activities
